PARISH COUNCIL VACANCY BECOME A COUNCILLOR!

The parish council is your local authority that makes decisions on behalf of the residents of Bletsoe. It is the level of government closest to the community, with the borough authority (Bedford Borough Council) above it in the hierarchy.

We meet once a month in the evening for the council meeting, to which members of the public are also invited. Meetings may last one or two hours, depending on the agenda set for the meeting and what needs to be discussed.

Come along and meet us and see if you'd like to join, or contact the Clerk for an easy application process. No specific council knowledge is required – this can be gathered along the way. To be a councillor you must be over 18 and:

- Lived or worked in Bletsoe for the last 12 months
- Or be on the electoral register for Bletsoe

Alternatively, if you know someone who could join and represent your interests then please encourage that person to stand as a councillor.
